

Allegro Residences

A NETWORK ACCREDITED FROM COAST TO COAST

Across Canada, several organizations and associations primarily aim in assisting the elderly by reuniting establishments sharing the same values and standards under one group. Allegro is proud to have among its residences, several members of these associations, namely the RQRA (Regroupement Québécois des Résidences pour Aînés), ORCA (Ontario Retirement Communities Association) and BCSLA (British-Columbia Senior Living Association).

Quebec

A first regulation of standards and measures has been passed in Quebec under Bill 83; a certification of conformity attributed by the MSSS (Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux), based on various social and sanitary criteria such as quality service, nutrition and security. Two new member residences of the Allegro network have obtained this certification in the past month, namely Faubourg Giffard, located in Quebec City, and Domaine des Trembles, located in the Outaouais region. These have been added to the list of over fifty percent of certified Allegro residences, to which all other residences will be added within the next months.

In the province of Quebec, the RQRA (Regroupement québécois des résidences pour aînés, formerly named ARCPQ (Association des Résidences et des CHSLD Privés du Québec)) is responsible of informing the elderly, which residences meet the requirements of respect, integrity and excellence. As for all Quebec Allegro residences, each one of these is represented by this distinguished organization.

Ontario

The majority of Ontario Allegro residences are accredited ORCA members, a non-profit association that inspects and accredits retirement establishments that meet their high standards. The organization requires, amongst others, that its members respect strict criteria of quality food services. It thereby reassures retirees with their choice of residences, by endorsing these with its seal of approval.

British Columbia

On the West Coast, the BCSLA promotes the development of the retirement residence industry in British Columbia and helps the clientele of these establishments make enlightened choices. This association notably proposes frequent training and professional consulting to its members, recommending improvement in all areas of their residences. Most Allegro residences in this province have this accreditation.
